Please be advised that this schedule may change due to weather and existing conditions found while performing the tasks below. This work may impact traffic and require lane and sidewalk closures limiting access to driveways and entrances to businesses.

What to Expect for the Week of October 14th to October 18th, 2024

- No work on Monday, October 14th - Indigenous Peoples' Day
- Overhead utility line transfer work continues on the west side of the project
- Brick strip installation will continue along the east side of the project.
- Resetting of wall by the walkway at 35 Main Street; a few cracked sidewalk panels onsite will also be removed.
- Amorello will be onsite on Tuesday to excavate the sidewalk in front of Town Hall for brick work. The entrance driveway to Town Hall will be closed during this work and the exit driveway will be two-way.

Detours or Alternating Traffic will be used as necessary.

- All 12 transformers have been delivered and installed.
- Eversource crews are working on the preliminary work associated with the transformers.
- The start of overhead to underground is expected to begin in early October.
